Medal Points

The player or players with the best net score in a qualifying medal will receive ten points. The player or players with the second best net score will receive nine points. This will be repeated down to the tenth best net score for one point.

Matchplay Points

The player or players winning the match play competition will receive ten points.
The beaten finalist/s will receive eight points.
The beaten semi-finalist/s will receive six points.
The beaten quarter-finalist/s will receive four points.
Those beaten in the last sixteen of the Singapore Cup and Watson Cup will receive two points.

Players Points

Players points from their best nine qualifying medals/match play competitions will be added to determine the winner. (ie. Players do not have to play all fourteen qualifying competitions)

In the event of a tie the best eight will decide, if still tied the best seven and so on until there is a winner.
